Conformance is Defined BY Industry, FOR Industry



CORE Certification is the most robust and widely-recognized industry program of its kind.

Requirements developed by broad, multi-stakeholder representation.



Conformance testing by an independent third party testing vendor.

CAQH CORE serves as a neutral, non-commercial administrator.

Voluntary CORE Certification: Benefits for Medicaid

Key benefits for State and Local Medicaid to pursue CORE Certification:

- Positions Medicaid as leaders in administrative efficiencies.
- Ensures real-time access to eligibility information for Medicaid beneficiaries.
- Allows hospitals and doctors to improve their revenue cycles by standardizing claim adjustment code combinations and making it easier to receive payments via EFT.
- Lowers cost within claim processing systems, including costly and cumbersome paper checks.
- Enhances opportunity for interoperability between providers and Medicaid.
- Improves relationships with hospitals and other providers.
- Gives assurance of conformance with federally mandated operating rules.

Voluntary CORE Certification: Unique Considerations for Medicaid

Unique State and Local Medicaid considerations in pursuing CORE Certification:

- Coordinating with other State/Federal Agencies (such as working with Treasury department on EFT operating rules)
- Patient financial responsibility, such as co-pays and deductibles
- Benefit-level eligibility
- Determination of test bed data
- Continuous search for innovation and efficiency
- Coordinating with vendors to become CORE-certified.
- Opportunities to coordinate and even pool resources with other state and local Medicaid.
- CORE Certification application fee is waived for government entities.



Who We Are

- SFHP is a public health plan founded in 1997
- We serve low income individuals in the city & county of San Francisco
- SFHP is the Local Initiative – LI in S.F. County.
 - LI comprises ~ 5.7 million Medicaid lives in CA
 - 16 California local health plans (see www.lhpc.org)
 - LHPC's are non-for-profit, publicly governed managed care org that do not compete against each other
- SFHP Medi-Cal Market Share 86% - #2 for Local Initiatives




California Medi-Cal Managed Care 6 Models

- Two-Plan Model (Local Initiative – LI) 5.7 Million
 - Temporary Aid for Needy Families (TANF) family members must enroll in managed care
 - Seniors and Persons with Disability (SPDs) mandatorily moved to managed care (June 11 – May 12)
 - Duals remain in Fee-for-Service (FFS)
 - One Local Public Plan and one Commercial Plan
- County Organized Health System (COHS) 1.9 Million
 - All Medi-Cal members must enroll in just a public plan
- Geographic Managed Care (GMC) 920,000
 - Multiple for profit and non profit health plans (other rules similar to 2 plan model)
- Regional 230,000
 - 2 Commercial plans (other rules similar to 2 plan model)
- Imperial 60,000
 - 2 Commercial plans (other rules similar to 2 plan model)
- San Benito 7,000
 - 1 Commercial Plan and members can still pick FFS







Overview


Thank you for your interest in CORE Certification. CAQH certifies and awards CORE Certification Seals to entities that create, transmit or use the administrative transactions addressed by the CAQH CORE Operating Rules. CORE Certification means an entity has demonstrated that its IT system or product is operating in conformance with a specific phase(s) of the CAQH CORE Operating Rules. Voluntary CORE Certification is available for providers, health plans, clearinghouses, and product vendors.

Organizations that do not create, transmit, or use administrative healthcare transactions, and therefore cannot implement the CAQH CORE Operating Rules, can demonstrate their support for the CORE mission and vision and operating rules by applying for and using the CORE Endorser Seal. Please refer to the CORE Endorser Seal: Application Process page for further information.

CORE Certification on phases of the CAQH CORE Operating Rules can be completed concurrently or successively. An entity may choose to test and become certified for Phase I, then Phase II, and later Phase III or undergo combined voluntary CORE Certification testing for all three phases concurrently. To become voluntarily certified on a higher phase of CAQH CORE Operating Rules an entity must be CORE-certified on the earlier phases.

The CORE Certification process has four components:

1. Pre-certification Planning and Systems Evaluation
2. Signing and Submitting the CORE Pledge and Appropriate Phase II and Phase III Addenda
3. CORE Certification Testing
4. Applying for the CORE Seal

Understand the applicability of rules to systems and trading partners that conduct the transactions

CAQH CORE Analysis and Planning Guide



Planning Guide should be used by project staff to:

Understand applicability of the CAQH CORE Operating Rule requirements to organization's systems and processes that conduct the transactions.

Identify all impacted external and internal systems and outsourced vendors that process the transactions.

Conduct detailed rule requirements gap analysis to identify system(s) that may require remediation and business processes which may be impacted.




